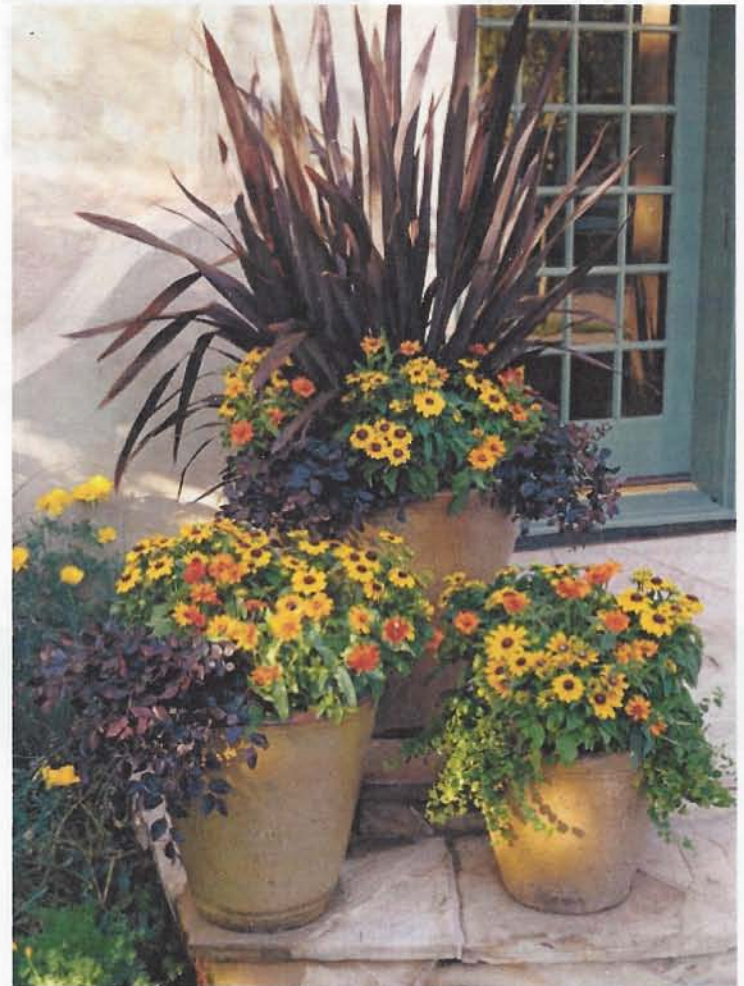
Harvest Guard(row cover) to cover your tender seedlings. You gain 5-7 degrees of protection.
Walls of Water for your tomatoes and tender vegetables.

NATURAL INSECT CONTROL

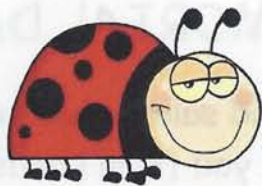
Don't let the insects overtake your plantings. We have all the good bugs you need for your garden.

Ladybugs are a natural way of ridding an area of aphids. They remain dormant stored in a cool place until you release them in the evening. Set up a Lady Bug

House to encourage them to stay.

Add some *Lacewings*. These insects can eat up to 1000 aphids a day. As the larvae hatch they crawl up the plants searching for nasty bugs.

For soil dwelling pests use *Nematodes*. these microscopic organisms destroy more than 230 different kinds of insects.
