BERRY HEAVY- Large bright orange-red berries are stunning in the winter. Leaves drop early resulting in a better fruit display. 6-8ft. tall and wide. Use Mr. Poppins as the pollinator.

MR. POPPINS-This winter berry is smaller than some, only 3-4ft. tall and wide. Use as a pollinator for Berry Heavy.

This true dwarf mugo offers year-round beauty with dense dark green needles and a consistent rounded form. Ideal for foundation plantings, rock gardens, and borders. 3-4ft. tall and 5-6ft. wide. Easy to grow, reliable, and very hardy.

Cherry: Lapins produce dark red fruit late in the season. Montmorency is an excellent tart pie cherry.

Stella cherries produce large delicious black fruit.

Apple: Haralred produces dark, pinkred fruit with a

sweet, tart flavor.

Honeycrisp apples are

fluorescent red with a

crunchy sweet, tart flavor.

Red & Yellow Delicious are

all time favorites.

Peach: Reliance peaches are excellent for colder areas.

Pear: Summercrisp should be harvested while still

green

to keep that sweet, crisp flavor.

Bartlett produces large golden yellow fruit that

is good for eating fresh or canning.

Plum: Toka plums are medium sized with rich flavor

beautiful color.

Prune: Italian prunes produce medium-sized purple fruit.

Some varieties will need a pollinator. Check with one of our staff members for information.

LAWNS: Spring 1-1 1/2 inches

Summer 2-3 inches

SHRUBS: Spring 1 inch

TREES: Spring 2 inches
Summer 3 inches
